Making dreams come true: Alumni fund student scholarships

MARIA MUÑOZ knows how to work hard. Within the past few years, she immigrated to the U.S., learned English, and earned her A.A. degree from Cabrillo College. Now a junior at Crown College, she says she wants to obtain a degree in business management economics at UCSC "because it is my dream . . . education

is the key to success."

Two UCSC Alumni Association programs are assisting students like Muñoz. This year, 54 students with financial need and the ability to overcome obstacles to higher education are collectively receiving \$130,000 in renewable Alumni Association Scholarship Fund awards. Another 11 students are receiving \$500 College Service Awards for promoting community among students.
